Upgrade all the Early Childhood Development School classrooms and structures by December 2013 to provide a safe, clean, productive and positive learning environment.





THE ECD SCHOOL FROM 2009 TO JUNE 2013

BEFORE

All the classrooms from 2009-2010 were built for around US\$500 each. The walls were made of half off-cut timers, blue gum supports and agricultural netting and the floors were kept as dirt floors. They met the needs for the time and with these classrooms 100 children have passed through to primary school.

The results from this construction project have been transformational. The ECD school currently has **50** pupils which benefit from **3** new classrooms and **1** new brightly painted dining hall. The volunteer staff of **6** benefit from a new large kitchen, **2** stores and **1** staffroom. The infrastructure of the school has improved as well as the quality of education that vulnerable children are now receiving.
